DRDINANCE # 2-76

CLOSED AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Board of the Town of Boulder Junction, Vilas County, Wisconsin, that the discharge of any high powered rifle, shotgun with slugs, or bow with hunting arrows, shall be prohibited in the area defined in Paragraph 2 of this ordinance. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that it shall be illegal to carry, or place in or on any vehicle, whether moving or standing, any high powered rifle, shotgun with slugs, or bow, unless such firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case, and such bow is unstrung or enclosed within a carrying case in the area defined in Paragraph 2 of this ordinance.

The point of beginning of this closed area shall be the junction of Highway M, at a point 0.3 mile south of the Boulder Junction Community Building, and the east-west road known as the South Boundary Road; commencing easterly 0.65 mile on the South Boundary Road; thence northerly along the East Boundary Road 0.25 mile; thence northeasterly 0.35 mile to the junction with Old Highway K; thence across Old Highway K to Little Rice Lake along the Hengsteller Road; thence westerly along the south shore of Little Rice Lake to the Manitowish River; thence westerly along the Manitowish River to Boulder Lake; thence southwesterly along the south shore of Boulder Lake; thence southwesterly along the south shore of Boulder Lake to the west Camp Manitowish Road; thence southerly 0.7 mile along the west Camp Manitowish Road to Highway K; thence across Highway K southerly 0.15 mile on an unimproved road to an east-west road; thence easterly 0.75 mile to the junction with a fire break road; thence southeasterly along the fire break road 0.65 mile to a north-south unimproved road; thence south and east 0.2 mile on this unimproved road to the point of beginning.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL be enforced by local law enforcement officers. Violators shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$200 for each violation.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL be in effect from and after its passage and posting as required by law.
