

BOULDER JUNCTION ANTI-LITTERING ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE # 2-77

The Boulder Junction Town Board of Supervisors assembled this 19th day of April, 1977, does hereby ordain as follows:

Any person, firm, or corporation who shall within the Town of Boulder Junction deposit or throw any rubbish, refuse, garbage, debris, or abandon articles within the limits of any public highway, may be required to forfeit not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and in default of payment thereof, may be confined to the Vilas County Jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or until such forfeiture shall have been paid.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part or provision is declared invalid the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting as required by law.
