

BOULDER JUNCTION DISORDERLY CONDUCT ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE # 3-77

The Boulder Junction Town Board of Supervisors assembled this 19th day of April, 1977, does hereby ordain as follows:

Whoever does any of the following, within the Town of Boulder Junction, may be required to forfeit not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and in default thereof, shall be confined in the Vilas County Jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or until such forfeiture shall be paid:

(1) In a public place or private place, engages in violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud, or otherwise disorderly conduct under the circumstances in which such conduct tends to cause or provoke a disturbance;

(2) Operates his motor vehicle in such manner as to cause undue noise, such as squealing of the tires, motor backfire, etc.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part or provision is declared invalid the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting as required by law.
