TOWN OF BOULDER JUNCTION

ORDINANCE CREATING A HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR ELDERLY PERSONS

Ordinance #2-92

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Boulder Junction has declared there is a need for an authority to function in the Town of Boulder Junction to create housing for elderly persons;

WHEREAS there is a need for housing for elderly persons due to a shortage of dwelling accommodations;

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BOULDER JUNCTION THAT:

Section 1 There is hereby established a housing authority for the Town of Boulder Junction. Such housing authority shall consist of up to nine members who must be residents of the Town of Boulder Junction. They shall be appointed and serve for the terms provided by Wisconsin Statute 66.40.

 $\underline{Section\ 2}$ Such housing authority shall constitute a municipal authority and shall perform the duties and have the powers granted to it by statute.

Section 3 Up to nine members of such authority shall be designated commissioners and shall select the Chairman and Vice Chairman and adopt by-laws, rules and regulations as provided by statute and may be removed for the causes enumerated in the statute.

Section 4 No commissioner or employee shall acquire any interest in any plan, project or contract to the authority. In the event that any such commissioner had acquired any interest in such project, contract or anything proposed by such authority, he shall make a complete written report which shall be entered upon the minutes of such authority.
