ORDINANCE # 3-71

WHEREAS the Town of Boulder Junction has, pursuant to Section 350.04 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, power and authority to designate streets marked as snowmobile routes,

NOW, THEREFORE, The Town Board of the Town of Boulder Junction, Vilas County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

1. That the following streets or roads are designated as snowmobile access routes:
 - A. The south 200 feet of Ada Street.
 - B. That part of Eilo Street which lies between Ada Street and Blueberry Lane.
 - C. That part of Blueberry Lane which lies north of Eilo Street.
2. No other town roads shall be used as snowmobile routes.
3. All of said snowmobile routes shall be appropriately marked with signs designated such routes before they can be traveled by snowmobiles.
4. Snowmobiles shall travel in the same direction as traffic, on the right side of the road, and while using the above-designated routes shall travel at a speed not to exceed 10 miles per hour.
5. All of the provisions of Chap. 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be applicable to persons operating snowmobiles within the Town of Boulder Junction.
6. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 and the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeitures and costs of prosecution. shall be imprisoned in the County jail until the forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid. but not to exceed 10 days.
7. Should any section clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
8. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and as required by law.

U. That portion of Dam Road which begins approximately one fifth mile (1056 feet) east of the intersection of Dam Road, High and Fishtrap Lake Road, and High Lake Road; and then extending approximately six tenths mile (3168 feet), more or less, to a point approximately one tenth mile (528 feet) from the eastern termination of Dam Road, and there ending. Dam Road lies entirely within Section 15, Township 42 North, Range 7 East in the Town of Boulder Junction.

A portion of Allen Road lying within Section 9, Township 42 North, Range 7 East, which begins approximately three tenths mile (1584 feet) east of the intersection of Allen Road and County Highway M, and then extending approximately one half mile (2640 feet), more or less, easterly to a point approximately one tenth mile (528 feet) west of the intersection of Allen Road and High Lake Road, and there ending.
