LINN NATURE AND CONSERVANCY PARK RULES

- 1. There shall be no use of the Town of Linn Park between the hours of 10:01 p.m. and 4:59 a.m. except by special permit granted by the Park Committee and Town Board. There shall be no use of the Town of Linn Park in areas where signs are posted indicating that the park or areas of the Park are closed.
- 2. There shall be no consumption of alcoholic beverages allowed in the Park.
- 3. There shall be no open fires. All fires must be contained in outdoor grills. Matches, cigarettes, cigars or pipe ashes must be extinguished before being disposed of.
- 4. There shall be no horses or other domesticated animals on the designated six acre parcel.
- 5. There shall be no motorized vehicles allowed beyond the parking area except for duly authorized maintenance vehicles and low-powered mechanically propelled vehicle specifically designed for those persons with physical disabilities.
- 6. Use of the Park sewage facilities shall be for human waste only.
- 7. All refuse/ litter generated as a result of the use of the Park shall be carried off the Park premises.
- 8. There shall be no dumping of any materials whatsoever on the Park premises.
- 9. There shall be no firearms, including paintball guns, bows and arrows, allowed in the park except by duly authorized law enforcement officials. There shall be no hunting, trapping or fishing allowed in the park except by duly authorized personnel.
- 10. No person may launch a boat, canoe or flotation device of any kind in the ponds or streams at the Park.
- 11. No person may plant or cultivate any plants, trees, shrubs, etc. unless first authorized by the Park Committee, Town Board and the Geneva Lake Conservancy.
