Wisconsin households, K-12 public schools and Parental Choice Program schools may recycle electronics through the E-Cycle Wisconsin program. Fax machines and desktop printers, including 3-D printers and printers combined with fax machines, scanners and copiers

DVD players, VCRs, DVRs and other video players
