Notice to voters: if you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initiated by two (2) election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initiated by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials (see end of ballot for initials).

To vote for a name on the ballot, fill in the oval next to the name like this: ● To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and fill in the oval next to the name like this: ● Statewide When voting for Governor and Lieutenant Governor, you have one of two choices: ● Vote for candidates on one ticket, <i>or</i> ● Write in names of persons on both write-in lines A write-in vote for only a Lieutenant Governor candidate will not be counted.
