Rules and Regulations

1. License Required: You must be 16 years old and have a Valid Driver's License. A learner's permit or occupational will not be accepted.
2. All golf carts must be registered and have a valid sticker issued by the Village of Barneveld prior to operation on any village streets. Proof of insurance must be on file with the application
3. The golf cart is equipped with a rear vision mirror and at least two red rear reflectors at least three inches in height and width. The golf cart also must be equipped with a reflective "slow moving sign" or "flag" on the rear of the cart.
4. The golf cart has all the standard safety features provided by the manufacturer including brakes and has not been modified to exceed a speed of 20 miles per hour, nor otherwise modified in any way that creates a hazard.
5. Golf carts may be driven on approved public streets from sunrise until sunset, except that golf carts equipped with at least one operating headlight, having at least a fifty -five -watt halogen, or equal, bulb on the front of the golf cart, and two operating tail lights on either side of the rear of the golf cart, all of which are visible for a distance of not less than 250 feet, may be operated from one half hour before sunrise until one half hour after sunset. Golf carts may not be operated when fog, smog, smoke or other conditions reduce visibility so that the golf cart is not visible for 250 feet.
6. All laws regarding the use of motor vehicles in the State of Wisconsin and all ordinances regarding the use of motor vehicles in the Village, not inconsistent therewith, shall be observed, except that no golf cart may be operated at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour. The operator of a golf cart shall yield the right-of-way to overtaking motor vehicles
7. Golf carts shall not be operated on any sidewalk, pedestrian walkway, jogging path, greenway, park, or trail.
8. No more than four passengers) shall not be exceeded nor shall the operator or any passenger be permitted to stand while the golf cart is in operation.
9. Golf carts may not be used as a taxicab or bus or for the commercial carrying of passengers or the hauling of freight.
10. Golf carts may only be parked in the same manner and at the same places designated for the parking of motor vehicles. The stopping, standing or parking of golf carts in areas where parking is not allowed or in any place that impedes the flow of traffic, pedestrian walkways or a passageway is prohibited.
11. Golf carts may not be used for the purpose of towing another cart, trailer or vehicle of any kind including a person on roller skates, skateboard or bicycle.
12. Golf carts are not designed for nor manufactured to be used on public streets and the Village neither advocates nor endorses the golf cart as a safe means. The Village in no way shall be liable for accidents, injuries or death involving the operation of a golf cart.
13. Any person who owns, operates or rides upon a golf cart on a public street, road or highway within the Village does so at his or her own risk and peril and assumes all liability resulting from the operation of the golf cart.
14. Golf carts will receive an annual inspection from the Police Chief before any registration is issued.
