### Park Shelter Rentals

**Including reserving use of Baseball Diamond and Multi-Sport Court**

Memorial Park and Birch Lake Park open May 1st, 2026. Please note that the Splash Pad is open Memorial Day through Labor Day.

The shelter at Memorial Park is priced as follows:

- Weekday (M-F) 9am - 3pm or 4pm - 10pm: \$150 rental fee plus \$100 deposit
- Weekend (S-S) full day: \$250 rental fee plus \$100 deposit

The shelters at Birch Lake Park is priced as follows:

- Both shelters: \$150 plus a \$100 refundable deposit.

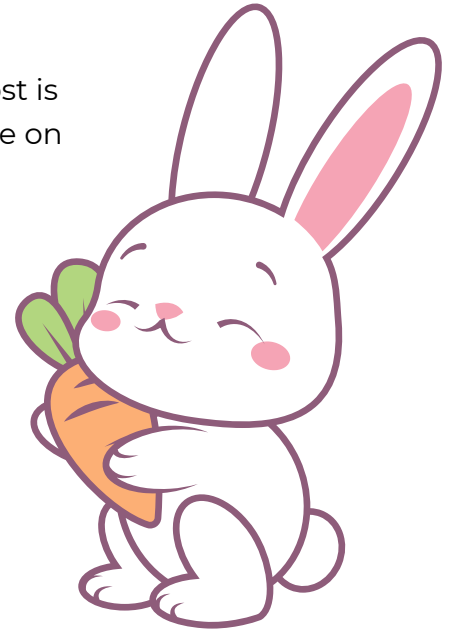
