

Amended Flag Ordinance 83-2
February 8, 2016

Section 1: Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to set forth the standards for the display of flags of Town of Phelps property.

Section 2: General Provisions

- (1) All flags and standards of the United States of America displayed on property owned by or under control of the Town of Phelps shall be:
 - (a) Displayed in accordance with all Presidential proclamation and directives or other orders of the Federal government to the end that such display by the Town shall conform to the manner of the display on federal property at the United States Post Office in the Town.
 - (b) Properly illuminated.
 - (i) If proper illumination is not possible, the flags shall be raised and lowered in accordance with federal code.
 - (c) Purchased with monies designated annually in the town budget.
- (2) This ordinance shall not limit the right of the Town to display the National Colors on its property at times when the same are not being displayed on federal property.
- (3) The operation of this ordinance may be suspended by majority vote of the Town Board of the Town of Phelps.

Section 3: Severability

- (1) If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
- (2) The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the County/Town would have passed the other provisions of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid.
- (3) This ordinance will be reviewed as deemed necessary.
- (4) This ordinance can be modified and/or repealed at any time should just cause be found for excessive violation and issues of harm and safety to the public or the environment.


Section 4: Effective Date

Following passage by majority vote of the Phelps Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.


