Our objective is to update you on the project scope and schedule and to obtain your input on the identified needs, proposed improvements, and traffic impacts along County A between WIS 17 and Eagle Farm Road, located in the town of Phelps, Vilas County.

- The County A asphalt pavement is deteriorating.
- Culverts throughout the corridor are showing signs of deterioration, which – if not improved – could lead to premature failure.

We are proposing to improve 4.0 miles of County A.

- Pulverizing the existing pavement and overlaying with new asphalt.
- Culvert pipe replacements.
- Paving roadway shoulders.
- Install new pavement markings.
- Replacing roadway signs.

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is currently scheduled for the summer of 2024 and is estimated to take four months to complete.

During construction, County A will be closed to through traffic for the replacement of the Deerskin River culvert. The roadway and small pipe culvert replacements will be constructed under flagging operations or temporary lane shifts. A detour will not be posted.

Access on County A will be maintained during construction for first responders, for property owners, and to recreational facilities. Brief interruptions in access may occur temporarily at driveways when crews are pulverizing and paving. The contractor will be required to notify homeowners and businesses prior to construction.

Real estate

Right-of-way needs are currently being evaluated. No real estate impacts are anticipated.
