Resolution #90-3

Whereas, the Town Treasurer of the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin, is required to execute and deliver to the Vilas County Treasurer, a Bond in compliance with Section 70.67(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

Whereas Section 70.67(2) Wisconsin Statutes provides for a method of avoiding this requirement through the adoption of an ordinance by the Town Board, now therefore,

Be it resolved, that the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin does obligate and guarantee the payment of all State and County taxes, required by law to be paid by the Town Treasurer to the Vilas County Treasurer, in case the said Town Treasurer should fail to do so.
