
Resolution 00-1 Uniform Dwelling Code Non-Enforcement Resolution


WHEREAS, Section 101.651 (2m)(b), WI Statutes, provides that municipalities of 2500 or less population that do not want enforcement of the Uniform Dwelling Code for one- and two-family dwellings, shall pass a resolution of the Uniform Dwelling Code for one-and two-family dwellings, shall pass a resolution to the effect that;

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Phelps shall not:

- *exercise jurisdiction over the construction and inspection of new one-and two-family dwellings under s. 101.65(1)(a),
- *exercise jurisdiction jointly with another municipality under s. 101.65(1)(b),
- *request under sub. 101.651(3)(a) that a county enforce this subchapter or an ordinance enacted under s. 101.65(1)(a) throughout the municipality,
- *request under sub. 101.651(3)(a) that a county provide inspection services in the municipality to administer and enforce this subchapter or an ordinance enacted under s. 101.65(1)(a).


Resolution 2000-02

Charge on Returned Checks for Non-sufficient Funds



Resolution #01-01







RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 02

RE: Adoption of Ward Plan for the Town of Phelps

1 **WHEREAS**, the Town of Phelps is required by Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes to
2 establish municipal wards to reflect population changes from the 2000 Census; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Vilas County Board of Supervisors has adopted a Tentative
4 Redistricting Plan and distributed the plan to the town pursuant to Section 59.10 of the Wisconsin
5 Statutes; and

6 **WHEREAS**, a copy of the adopted ward plan must be submitted to the Vilas County
7 Clerk within 60 days of receipt of the Vilas County Tentative Redistricting Plan; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Town of Phelps's population according to the 2000 Census is 1350 persons.

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Board of Phelps, in session
10 this 16 day of Aug, 2001, that we adopt the wards to include the census blocks as detailed in
11 the attachment; and

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the polling place for all wards in the town is the
13 Phelps Town Hall located on Town Hall Road; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the ward boundaries are established as follows:

15 **Phelps - Ward 1**


16 Beginning at intersection of the North Town boundary and Boot Lake Road - continue
17 Southeasterly, South, and West along exterior Town boundary to Deerskin Road - Northerly and
18 Northeasterly along Deerskin Road to St. Louis Road - East along St. Louis Road to Volkman
19 Road - North along Volkman Road to Strong Road - East along Strong Road to Co-op Road -

20 Northerly along Co-op Road to STH 17 - East along STH 17 to Boot Lake Road - North and
21 Northeasterly along Boot Lake Road to Place of Beginning.

22 **Phelps - Ward 2**

23 Beginning at the NW corner of the Town of Phelps - continue Southeasterly along North Town
24 boundary to Boot Lake Road - Southwesterly and Southerly along Boot Lake Road to STH 17 -
25 Westerly along STH 17 to Co-op Road - Southerly along Co-op Road to Strong Road - West
26 along Strong Road to Volkman Road - South along Volkman Road to St. Louis Rd - West along
27 St. Louis Road to Deerskin Road - Southerly and Southwesterly along Deerskin Road to South
28 Town boundary - West along South Town boundary and continue to follow exterior Town
29 boundary to Place of Beginning.


