**Resolution Vacating Town Road  
Pursuant to Section 66.1003 of the Wisconsin State Statutes**

Be it hereby petitioned that the Board of the Town of Phelps, pursuant to Section 66.1003 initiates the discontinuance of the public way based upon the fact that the public interest requires it and that the following road located in the N 1/2-SW 1/4-NW 1/4 of Section 36 and in the N 1/2-SE 1/4-NE 1/4 of Section 35 all in T42N., R.11 E., Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin be vacated by the Town of Phelps.

**Coveyville Road**

Further, the Phelps Town Board shall set a Public Hearing on the passage of this Resolution which shall occur not less than forty (40) days after the date on which the Resolution is introduced.

Furthermore, the Town Board of Phelps shall give notice of the Public hearing by publishing this Resolution as a Class 3 notice under Chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Further, the Notice of this Public Hearing shall be served on owners of all frontage of the lots and lands abutting the public way in the same manner provided for the service of Summons in Circuit Court at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing.

WHEREAS, the demand for a variety of outdoor recreation activities is increasing, and




WHEREAS, outdoor recreation facilities are important amenities supporting the tourism industry, and



WHEREAS, the State and the Board will match the annual contributions, made by a municipality choosing to participate in the Program on behalf of its volunteer firefighters, up to a statutory maximum per individual, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Phelps wishes to participate in the Program for the benefit of its volunteer firefighters, and agrees to abide by all pertinent State and Federal statutes, regulations, rules and procedures pertaining to the Program, as well as any requirements of the private vendor chosen by the Town of Phelps; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Phelps agrees to develop standards for determining the service required of its volunteer firefighters in order to qualify for an annual contribution:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, that the Town of Phelps Hereby declares that it shall participate in the State of Wisconsin Length of Service Award Program and that it shall abide by all pertinent statutes, rules, regulations, procedures and other requirements of the Program.



#### **Policy and Procedure requirements:**


1. Any eligible EMT must perform to the extent described herein after in any given year to receive the amount pre-determined by the State of Wisconsin and the Town Board of Phelps for the retirement program.
2. The EMT shall attend at least 9 of 12 squad meetings each year.
3. The EMT shall take at least 100 hours of call time each month or a combined total for the year of 1200 hours.
4. The EMT shall not be eligible their first year of service, they shall be recommended by the EMS Supervisor after the first year of Active service (EMT-Temp not included).
5. The EMT shall attend and help at the One Big Fund raiser in August "Picnic in the Park", and for other small fund raisers, shall participate as needed

## PHELPS FIRE DEPARTMENT LOSA/PENSION ELIGABILITY REQUIRMENTS

The Phelps Fire and EMS LOSA/Pension Plan is adopted December 2002

Phelps EMS personnel will be covered in a separate document

Firefighters must be in good standing with the department having completed Fire Fighter 1 as well as 1 year of service.

Firefighters and EMS are only eligible for 1 contribution as either a Firefighter or EMS.

Firefighters must attend and participate in at least 75% of all Training sessions per year.

Firefighters must attend and participate in both fundraisers per year unless the chief grants an excuse.

Firefighters must attend 50% of all the meetings per year.

Testing out with or scheduling a make-up with either the chief or training officer can make up training sessions.

Other meetings can be made up with approval of the chief or other officer in charge in the chief's absence.

Individual firefighters are required to monitor their eligibility during each year.

The secretary, chief or officer in charge will keep attendance for every meeting.

The secretary will provide the town board a list of eligible members each year to be submitted to the LOSA Pension Plan.
