Authorization to Abolish the Office of Town Constable

WHEREAS, the Town of Phelps established the jurisdiction and duties of the town constable of the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes Section 60.22(4) and Section 60.35 of 1985 Wisconsin Act 532; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 85-1 Jurisdiction and Duties of Town Constable was adopted at a Regular Town Board Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Phelps on January 14, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that over the years the Statues have changed the general powers and duties of a town constable to include not less than 600 hours of training, pursuant to Wisconsin State Statues Section 165.85(4) and Section 60.35(1) town constables shall be paid as prescribed for sheriff's; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to abolish the Office of Town Constable pursuant to State Statutes 60.10(1)(b)4. effective at the end of the term of the person serving in the office; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the town meeting of the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting at a Special Town Meeting this 13th day of November 2025, with proper notice assembled and voting, resolves and orders to abolish the Office of Town Constable effective at the end of the term of the person serving in the office. Said term to expire April 19, 2027.
