#### Town Highway Positions Open

The Town of Middletown Springs is seeking to build out our crew for years to come, and is looking for candidates to fill two positions.

The first position is someone who will serve as the **Highway** Foreman's Apprentice during the final year of our current foreman's excellent service before his retirement. If the apprenticeship period is successful, our hope is that this person will be prepared to take on the role of highway foreman in October 2024.

This is a supervisory position, reporting to the foreman but overseeing the work of other highway crewmembers. It also entails collaboration with other regional, state, and federal agencies; negotiating and contracting with vendors; writing funding proposals for grants; careful recordkeeping; and excellent communication with the public and with the selectboard. A valid Vermont-issued CDL Class B license or above is required. Required skills include proficient operation and maintenance of a road grader, excavator, front-end loader, backhoe, and tandem plow truck. The pay is competitive and dependent on qualifications. Benefits include: health insurance, paid time off, pension plan, and 12 paid holidays.

The second position is a Highway Equipment Operator / Maintenance Worker. This is a full-time, year-round position. Principle duties will include plowing snow, sanding, and salting roads, road construction and maintenance, and other related duties. A valid Vermont-issued CDL Class B license or above is required. Candidates for this position will have experience operating a dump truck with plow, sander, loader and excavator, backhoe, and/or grader. Good communication with the public and with the selectboard are expected. General knowledge of vehicle maintenance, fundamental roadway construction and maintenance procedures, equipment operation, and project recordkeeping are a plus. The pay is competitive and dependent on qualifications. Benefits include: health insurance, paid time off, pension plan, and 12 paid holidays.

# A Note from the Town Treasurer

Payment for 2nd quarter 23/24 property tax is due on or before Friday, December 15.

Payments can be made as follows:

- 1. MAIL to PO Box 1022, Middletown Springs, VT 05757 (with a 12/15/23 or earlier postmark.)
- 2. Deposit in the NEW black mail slot on the OUTSIDE wall of the town office (to the left of the South Street entrance door) by the end of the day of 12/15/23.

Please do not remit tax payments to the town clerk, as she is not authorized to accept them.

Tax payments received or postmarked after December 15, 2023 will incur a late fee of 1% for 3 months and 1.5% thereafter until paid.

# Pleasant View Cemetery Gate Closed for the Season

The entrance gate to the Pleasant View Cemetery will be CLOSED on or shortly after December 1, 2023, for the winter months. We try and leave the gate open as long as reasonably possible in order to allow for the placement of Christmas wreaths and remembrances on loved ones memorials around the Thanksgiving holiday. With the onset of the winter season and the increasing likelihood of snow and ice, visitor access to the site must be limited to foot traffic for public safety concerns.

We encourage patrons to remove old and faded decorations, artificial flowers (which are not allowed), and dead or dying plants around their loved ones grave sites. It is a big task to keep the grounds mowed and manicured in a presentable manner during the summer months, and we are grateful for the fine job that Green Mountain Boys landscaping from Wells, VT, does for us in managing this property.

We expect to work with the 6th grade class from Middletown Springs Elementary School again next April for assistance with the spring cleanup effort. Until then, enjoy a safe and healthy winter season, and the entrance gate will be open again on or around the first of May, 2024.
