Theresa Ambulance Service ran 265 calls for 2012. That is an increase of 8 calls over 2011. Of those 265 calls we ran 7 intercepts with Flight for Life, 9 intercepts with Fond du Lac, and 4 intercepts with West Bend. 63 calls were either no transports or for lift assists. We also did 16 standbys at fire calls for either Theresa Fire or for Lomira Fire. We also did 14 standbys for the Lomira School District for football games. This number is not included in the run total.

We had two people complete their EMT Intermediate Training this past year. We currently have 14 EMT Intermediate Techs, 4 EMT Basics. 11 Drivers. Current roster total is 29.

For 2012 the ambulance traveled a total of 10,126 miles. This includes all the calls and standbys and practices.

From Your Village Clerk~Treasurer:

The Village Clerk – Treasurer's Office is located at the Village Hall, 202 S. Milwaukee Street. Our staff consists of a full-time Clerk – Treasurer and a part-time Deputy Clerk – Treasurer. We are responsible for and perform a large number of duties and like many of you, we have been faced with several new challenges during the past few years. As we all know, technology continues to evolve at a fast pace. Balancing the annual budget has certainly become one of my/our biggest challenges and the election laws and procedures are continually changing.

Last year was exceptionally busy in the clerk's office due to the fact that in addition to our normal scope of duties, we prepared for and administered the elections held in April, May, June, August and November. The residents of the Village should be very proud because the Village met or exceeded the predicted percentage of voters for most of the elections held in 2012. The November election was particularly well attended with 717 village registered voters casting their vote, which includes 87 new registrants and 78 that voted absentee either in the clerk's office or by mail. This is the largest number of absentee voters on record in the Village.

The Village is currently in the preliminary stages of closing its one and only Tax Incremental District (TID). Please keep an eye out for further details, future updates and newspaper articles regarding the closure and success of the TID.

In closing, I'd like to encourage you to stop by our office next time you are in need of village related information. My goal is to provide the residents with timely and accurate information along with friendly and courteous service. Please feel free to stop by any time. -

Help Keep Your Community Clean

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited, dump, sort, scatter or leave any rubbish, stone, wire, earth, ashes, cinders, sawdust, hay, glass, manure, filth, paper, snow, ice, dirt, grass, leaves, construction waste, garbage or other offensive or noxious material in any PUBLIC STREET, sidewalk, or alley or upon any public property or upon any property of another, without the express permission of the owner or occupant thereof. Any person who violates the abovementioned ordinance may be subject to forfeiture.

Fireworks-July4th

Best wishes from the police department. Hope you have a great summer and July 4th. With each summer comes inquiries and complaints to the PD about the use of consumer fireworks. As a reminder, the purchase, possession or ignition of consumer fireworks can be unsafe for the user and lead to devastating burns, injuries and fires. Per State Law, any item that emits smoke, flies in the air or goes BOOM is illegal and is subject to confiscation and or a fine being issued. Please respect your neighbors and enjoy the safe and legal displays this summer as celebrate our Nation's Birthday!



Open Burning

Per Village Ordinance 5-2-9, no person, firm or corporation shall build any outdoor fire within the Village limits. This prohibition includes burning of GARBAGE, YARD WASTE, CONSTRUCTION WASTE, and DEBRIS at construction sites. Exceptions to this section include ceremonial campfires, or outdoor cooking in/or over a fire contained in a device or structure approved by the Fire Chief Warren Stanke at 488-5300....

Building Permits

If you are contemplating a remodeling, fence, deck or any other construction project, be sure to check with the Building Inspector to find out what zoning requirements apply and/or to purchase permits. 
SNOW REMOVAL

The owner, occupant, or person in charge of every building, lot or part of a lot within the Village, shall remove all snow and ice from said sidewalk within 24 hours from the time the snow has ceased to fall. If the snow/ice is not removed, the Village may clear the snow/ice from the sidewalk "without" written notice and return the cost to the property owner (\$100 per hour/\$100 minimum). Please keep the safety of your family and neighbors in mind by removing snow/ice from any fire hydrant near your property. The Theresa Fire Department would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation. If you use a cluster mailbox or have a cluster mailbox located on or near your property, please take the time to remove the ice/snow from around the box and keep the sidewalk leading to the cluster mailbox clear.

BRUSH, GRASS AND WEEDS

Please keep lawns and grasses under 6" in length for public health and safety. For a list of noxious weeds that must be destroyed prior to the bloom or flower state please see §127-1(c) under the Ordinances tab on the Village website www.villageoftheresa.com.





All Cats and dogs 6 months of age or older need to be licensed by April 1st of every year. Proof of rabies, spaying and neutering is required. Remember to pick up solid pet feces. Bulk Pick-Up

October 15, 2013 & April 15, 2014

The Village holds two bulk pick-ups per year, the third Tuesday of April and the third Tuesday of October. There may be a fee associated with the bulk pick-up of tires and appliances. The Village is no longer authorized to pick up computers, computer monitors, printers, fax machines, cell phones, TVs, DVD players, or VCRs. Other excluded items are recyclables, building waste, or other items that may be disposed of as a regular weekly pick up.

YARD WASTE

Yard waste (leaves, lawn clippings, branches, etc) is not picked up at Bulk Pick-Up or with regular trash pick-up. Yard waste disposal site is located behind River's Edge Park. Brush goes on the brush pile. Lawn clippings, leaves, small plants and garden waste go into the dumpster. Please take your containers and bags with you. No timbers, landscape edging are allowed.

DUMPING OF GARBAGE, FURNITURE, CARPETING and/or ANY OTHER NONE YARD WASTE ITEM IS PROHIBITED! VIOLATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE!
