



cellphone or a neighbor's phone. Stay
outside until the fire Department says it's
safe to go back inside your home. It's also
important to make sure that your house
numbers are visible from the road or street
& mounted on the front of your property so
that emergency services can easily find your
location.

Village Ordinance Section 127-3

<u>Purpose:</u> This section is adopted due to the unique nature of the problems associated with lawns, grasses and noxious weeds being allowed to grow to excessive length in the Village of Theresa.

If you are having trouble (issues) with your water...

(no water, rusty water, smelly water, storm water run-off, etc.), you will get faster service by calling the Department of Public Works directly @ (920) 488-4003, please feel free to leave a message.

Grass & Leaves Reminder

It is unlawful to blow your grass clippings or rake leaves into the street. Grass clippings & leaves clog up sewer grates & prevent proper drainage during heavy rainstorms. Violators may be fined!

The Theresa Sewer & Water Utility Department would appreciate it if you would write your account number on the memo line of your check when making a utility payment. Thank you for your cooperation!

DEBIT & CREDIT CARD UTILITY PAYMENTS NOW AVAILABLE!

Village of Theresa Sewer & Water Utility customers have the option to pay their sewer & water utility bill online with a debit or credit card 24/7! Go to the Village website at www.villageoftheresa.com, click Resources, then click Payments, on the Payments page, click the green GovPayNet box to start the process.

Please note that GovPayNet charges a non-refundable service fee!

Change of Mailing Address for Sewer & Water Utility Billing

Please remind us to change your mailing address before you leave for an extended period of time during the winter or summer & when you come back to reside in Theresa. You can notify us by calling (920) 488-5421 (feel free to leave a message), by stopping at the Village Hall (202 S Milwaukee St) during normal business hours, by mail at PO Box #327, Theresa, WI 53091, or by placing a note in the "payment" box located outside the door of the Village Hall. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!



If you're contemplating filling your swimming pool and are interested in receiving a SEWER credit, we need to receive your request in writing. Write down your sewer & water utility meter reading before you fill & after you fill your pool. Drop off the meter reading numbers, along with your name, address & utility account number at the Village Hall, or place it in the "payment" box located next to the door at the Village Hall.

BULK PICK-UP

- The Village holds two Bulk Pick-ups per year, one on the third Tuesday in April (4/16/2019) & one on the third Tuesday in October (10/15/2019). Bulk items & tires will be collected curbside right along with the regular garbage & recycling pick-up.
- There will be a fee associated with the bulk pick-up of tires & appliances. Bills will be sent after pick-up as required.
- If you have questions on what items will be collected, please contact Advanced Disposal Services @ (920) 387-0987.
- The Village can no longer accept electronics. These items can/should be reused or donated. For more information on e-cycling & where to recycle electronics, visit www.dnr.wi.gov/ecyclewisconsin. Click "Find" for electronics collection sites nearby.
- Building materials are NOT accepted as part of Bulk Pick-Up. Please contact Advanced Disposal Services @ (920) 387-0987 for dumpster rental.
- Garbage bags laying on the ground or near the waste cart will NOT be picked up unless they are placed in the green waste cart.
- Cardboard boxes must be broken down & placed in or near the recycling bin.
- Yard waste will NOT be accepted & should be disposed of at the yard waste/brush site located at River's Edge Park from April through November (weather permitting). Please follow all rules & regulations at drop-off site.
- Please place all items on the curb in an orderly fashion.

DO NOT PUT ITEMS ON THE CURB PRIOR TO THE WEEKEND BEFORE BULK PICK-UP!



Leaves, lawn clippings, branches, etc. are not picked up during bulk pick-up or with the regular weekly pick-up. Yard waste disposal site is located behind River's Edge Park.

Brush goes on the brush pile. Lawn clippings, leaves, small plants and garden waste go on the yard waste pile. Please take your containers and bags with you. No timbers or landscaping edging allowed. No other items other than yard waste are to be dumped at this site! Dumping of garbage, furniture, carpeting, building material and/or any other non-yard waste items is prohibited!

If you're contemplating a remodeling, shed, fence, deck or any other construction project, be sure to check with the Building Inspector to find out what zoning requirements apply and/or to purchase a building permit. The Inspector (Doc) can be reached by calling (262)-364-9597. Zoning & building codes & printable building permit application can be found on the Village website www.villageoftheresa.com. Failure to obtain a building permit in a timely manner could result in double fees being assessed!

OPEN BURNING

Per Village Ordinance 5-2-9, no person, firm or corporation shall build any outdoor fire within the Village limits.

This prohibition includes burning of GARBAGE, YARD WASTE & CONSTRUCTION WASTE.

Exceptions to this section include ceremonial campfires, or outdoor cooking in/or over a fire contained in a device or structure approved by Fire Chief Warren Stanke call (920) 488-5300 BEFORE BURNING!!!!!!

PET INFORMATION

All dogs & cats 6 months or older must be licensed by April 1st of every year. Proof of spaying/neutering & rabies vaccination is required. The cost of the license is \$15 for males/females & \$10 for spayed or neutered animals. There is now a pet licensing application form on the Forms page of the Village of Theresa website.

Be a polite pet owner by picking up all solid feces from any street, sidewalk, alley or private or public property. Violators will be subject to fines & forfeiture.

No person having ownership or possession of any animal shall allow the animal to run at large in the Village. For more information visit the Village website at www.villageoftheresa.com.



2019 ELECTIONS There is one election scheduled for 2019: April 2nd – Spring Election. **Elections are held at the Theresa Public Library located at 290 Mayville Street in the village**; polls are open from 7am – 8pm. Prior to each election, the required notices & sample ballots are available for viewing on the posting board in front of the Village Hall. You can also obtain various election & Photo ID information by visiting www.myvote.wi.gov & www.bringit.wisconsin.gov. As a reminder, you must be registered to be eligible to vote & voter Photo ID is required. We urge all voters to plan ahead by making sure they have an acceptable Photo ID. If you're a new village resident & are interested in saving yourself some time on Election Day, stop by the Village Hall to register to vote...proof of residency is required to register.



<u>What Are Your Office Hours</u>? Normal business hours for the Clerk – Treasurer's Office located at 202 S. Milwaukee Street are Monday thru Thursday, 8am – 4pm and Fridays from 8am – Noon. *These hours are subject to change from time-to-time and will be posted accordingly, if possible, on the front door of the Village Hall.*

Who Should I Contact?

- <u>Village Building Inspector</u> "Doc" at (262) 364-9597 for building codes questions, concerns, requirements and the issuance of building permits.
- Assessor Grota Appraisals at (262) 253-1142 for questions, or concerns regarding the assessment of your property.

<u>Where Do I Vote</u>? Elections are held, and '<u>VILLAGE'</u> residents vote at the Theresa Public Library located at 290 Mayville Street in the village; polls are open from 7am – 8pm. You must register and vote in the municipality in which you reside.

<u>Where Do I Live</u>? If your address is three numbers long, followed by a street name you live in the VILLAGE OF THERESA. Example: 202 S. Milwaukee Street is a VILLAGE ADDRESS. Village residents should take care of municipal business at the VILLAGE HALL, 202 S. Milwaukee Street. If your address starts with the letter "N" or "W" you live in the TOWN OF THERESA (with one exception). Town residents should take care of municipal business at the THERESA TOWN HALL located at N8679 County Hwy P or, by calling the Town Clerk – Diane Steger at (920) 488-2033.

Where Can I Find Information about Sewer Lateral Repair and/or Replacement? Go to the Village of Theresa website at www.villageoftheresa.com, click on the Resources Tab, click on Village of Theresa Code of Ordinances, then search for Code Section 280-14 - "Sewer Lateral Inspection Requirements". Please contact the Village Director of Public Works, Nate Bodden by calling (920)488-4003 with any questions or concerns you may have regarding this ordinance. Or, feel free to attend a Monthly Village Board Meeting.

<u>When are Village Board Meetings Held</u>? Regular Monthly Board Meetings are held the 1st Monday of every month at 7pm, at the Village Hall, 202 S. Milwaukee Street; committee meetings begin at 6:30pm.

How do I Make a Payment? You can make a payment in person at the Village Hall, located at 202 S. Milwaukee Street or, you can also send your payment to Village of Theresa at PO Box 327, Theresa, WI 53091. You can also make a sewer & water utility payment online with a debit or credit card at www.villageoftheresa.com. For your convenience, the village also has a "**SECURE PAYMENT BOX**" located outside the door of the Village Hall. This box can be used for payments and all other village and utility correspondence.

How Do I Obtain a Property Tax Receipt? - You have three options:

- 1. Provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with along your tax payment.
- 2. Stop by the Village Hall, or call the Clerk Treasurer's Office during normal business hours and request a copy.
- 3. After January 5th and February 5th you can view and print a tax payment receipt from the Dodge County website at www.co.dodge.wi.gov.

Why Did I Get an Invoice for Snow Removal? During the past few years the Public Works Committee directed the public works employees to inspect and strictly enforce the Village's sidewalk snow removal ordinance. Per the ordinance, the owner or person in charge of a property has 24-hours from the time the snow ceases to fall to remove ALL snow and ice from the sidewalk. If ICE on the sidewalk cannot be removed the sidewalk shall be kept sprinkled with ashes, salt, sand or like material. If the owner refuses or neglects to remove the snow/ice from the sidewalk, the Village will remove it and return the cost to the property owner; WITHOUT NOTICE! This ordinance is available for viewing in its entirety on the village website – Section 303-8 'Snow and Ice Removal'.

<u>Does the Village Provide Leaf Pick Up Service</u>? No, the village does NOT provide curb side leaf pick up. All yard waste needs to be disposed of at the yard waste dump site located in River's Edge Park. This site is for "YARD WASTE ONLY". Violators will be issued a citation.
