

ORDINANCE 22-03

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Bovina
Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to reduce the speed limit on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective July 22, 2022, speed limits on certain Town of Bovina town highways are reduced or modifies as follows: Boelter Road is reduced to 45 MPH from Hooyman Rd south to State Hwy 54.
- B. Pursuant to s.349.11 (5), Wis stats., the town chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-mentioned-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on November 16, 2022.

The town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
