ORDINANCE 23-02

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Bovina Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been, given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highway in the Town of Bovina is subject to the following restrictions and limitations: Parking is not allowed on the east side of Van Patten Drive from Hwy 54 to 100 yards north of the dyke.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject towing of vehicle at owner's expense.

This ordinance is effective on September 17, 2023.

The town clerk shall properly post/publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
