ORDINANCE 03-2012

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Bovina Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to reduce the speed limit on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective April 1, 2012, speed limits on certain Town of Bovina town highways are reduced or modifies as follows: Thompson Road from the town line north to County Highway A is reduced to 45 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to s.349.11 (5), Wis stats., the town chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-mentioned-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on April 1, 2012.

The town clerk shall properly post/ publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
