Town of Bovina – Ordinance 16-01

Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s.349.15 (2) , Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote, with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highway as class “B” highways in the town as follows:

The following town highway in the Town of Bovina are designated class “B” highways, subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance: Boelter Road, Hwy 76 south to Hwy 54.

The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

- A. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set for in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on publication.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
