

RESOLUTION 24-01
ADOPTION OF OUTAGAMIE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

JULY 22, 2024

Whereas, the Town of Bovina recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town of Bovina, Outagamie Count; and

Whereas the Outagamie County Emergency Management Department has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as “Outagamie County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024-2029” (the Plan) in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended: and

Whereas, The Ougagamie County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024-2029 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County from the impacts of future hazards and disaster: and

Whereas, the adoption of the Outagamie County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024-2029 by the Town of Bovina demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: the Town Board of the Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, Wisconsin does adopt the Outagamie County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024-2029. While content related to Town of Bovina, Outagamie County, may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the Town of Bovina to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
