LRS is contracted to pick up trash and recycling in your bins. NOTE: if there is an observed holiday on any weekday, your pickup will occur on Saturday that week (as indicated above). If you have a complaint or concern, or want to dispose of something that doesn't fit in your bins, contact LRS at 608-580-0580 or Bltownservice@Irsrecycles.com.

YARD WASTE (collected by your Public Works staff: Cory & Steve)

Spring Collection - April 1 through May 15.

Autumn Collection - October 15 through November 30 - unless early snowfall gets in the way.

- * Collection takes place throughout the Town once a week during the timeframes stated above.
- * Yard waste must be bagged, with bags weighing no more than 40 pounds and tied at the top.
- * For those so inclined, the use of biodegradable paper bags (instead of plastic) is appreciated. It's good for the environment, and streamlines the disposal process for the Public Works staff. Thank you!

BRUSH (chipped by your Public Works staff: Cory & Steve)

- * Chipping is done throughout the Town once a week in the months of April, May, September and October.
- * Chipping is done throughout the Town twice a month in June, July and August.
- * Chipping is done throughout the Town once a month from November through March (unless snow gets in the way).
- * Brush is to be piled as neatly as possible with the butt ends facing towards the road, and stacked in piles no more than 4 feet high, 8 feet wide and 12 feet long. Brush that is 6" in diameter or less can go through the chipper; larger pieces can't.
- * The Town will chip up to 4' x 8' x 12' worth of material, per property per time out.
- * If an entire tree (over 6" in diameter) is being removed, the property owner or other person that took the tree down is responsible for removing all the material from that tree from the property.
- * If the property owner pays anyone to do the work, the property owner or who they hire is responsible for removing all of that material from the property.
