coaches and Youth sports play a vital role in encouraging physical, social and emotional growth of children. It is therefore essential for parents, c officials to encourage their youth sport players to embrace the values of good sportsmanship, discipline and character development.

Player Expectations:

- Have fun!
- Be a good sport (win or lose), be honest, fair and always show good sportsmanship to all coaches, players, officials and fans.
 - Learn the value of commitment to the team.
- Put personal goals aside for the betterment of the team.
- Show courtesy and respect to teammates, opponents and coaches.
- Realize that athletic contests, including practice sessions are educational experiences and opportunities.
- Players will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - Players will not engage in rude behavior. 0
- Players will treat everyone, including coaches, parents, players and officials with respect.

PARENT/VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents are vital to the development of young athletes. Whether sitting in the stands or helping as a volunteer, parents must set a positive example. Parents and adults involved in youth sports should be models of good sportsmanship and lead by example on and off the playing field.

- Give constructive criticism
- Support your coach, and refrain from excessive "sideline coaching" from the stands.
- of the officials. Parents must stay off the field and Accept the decisions of officials on the field as being fair and called to the best ability remain under control in order to set a good example for players and other spectators.
 - Do not criticize an opposing team, its players, fans, coaches, or team, by words or gestures.
- Support the coaches, players and officials and help teach the value of commitment to the teams, sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and fair 6
- Inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate ejection from the stands. Repeat offenses will result in being barred from future games and league sponsored activities. .
 - Parents will not encourage their child, or any other person, to engage in unsportsmanship conduct with any coach, parent, player, participants, officials, or any other attendee. .
 - Parents will attend games as parents, and they will allow coaches to coach
- All Volunteers must adhere to the code of conduct. If this cannot be done, then the parent/volunteer will be asked to leave the facility. Coaches need to be able to work with all parents, youth kids, refs/umps, other community coaches, and Village employees.

Palmyra Park and Rec prohibits and will not tolerate acts of harassment, intimidation, and bullying (including cyber-bullying). "Harassment, intimidation or bullying" means any gesture, any written, verbal, or physical act, or any electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents that:

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- Is reasonably perceived as being motivated by either any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical, or sensory disability; or takes place in relation to any program function or team.

 Will have the effect of physically or emotionally harming an individual or damaging the individual's property, or placing an individual in reasonable fear of physical or emotional harm to his/her person or damage to his/her property; or Has the effect of insulting or demeaning any player, coach, spectator, ump/ref, Park and Rec Director or group of players; or creates a hostile environment for the individual by interfering with an individual's participation or by severely or pervasively causing physical or emotional harm to the individual.

CONSEQUENCES FOR EXCESSIVE POOR BEHAVIOR:

- You will be asked to stop the behavior
 You will be removed from the game or practice
 You will be removed from coaching or assistant coaching
 You will be removed from coaching or assistant coaching
 You will be asked to not attend games or practices for an extended period of time or permanently pending the severity of your actions.
