Village Yard Waste Site Hours

The Yard Waste Site closes Nov. 29th, 2025 for the winter and will reopen on Sat. April 4, 2026 and be open the 1st Saturday of ea. Month April through November for Village residents only. You may bring bagged weeds, leaves and small twigs. Saturday Hours: 8am – Noon. Do Not Rake Leaves into the Street! Electronic Waste Dates: Sat. June 13, 2026. TV's, computers, etc. 430 Jefferson St. Palmyra, Village residents only.



All dogs & cats kept in the Village **must be licensed** and show proof of current rabies vaccination. 2026 licenses will be available at the Village Hall. Avoid a possible citation from the Police-get your pets licensed BEFORE March 31st, 2026! And remember it is your responsibility to pick up after your pets when walking them. Brush chipping-until Nov. 10, 2025

Chipping will resume the 2nd Monday of each month April – Nov 2026. Have materials to the curbside by 7 am. No more than 4" dia. or greater than 8 ft. long. Do not bundle or place in containers. This is for general maintenance, NOT tree removal.
