Winter Aerator Operations Update

All systems are working fine and Mike Lendzion rebuilt all 3 units in December to insure proper operation. Some maintenance will need to be done to Aerator building this summer as roof has water issues.

Lake Maintenance Activities

Ken and Barry had a recent conference call with Casons & Associates to plan the spring weed survey and chemical Spraying activities. Casons is ready to act as soon as conditions are ideal. Ken Roberts also has been in contact with DNR and Adams County Lakes to do some additional lake surveys to better understand weed activity and challenges.

New Business

The Goose Control Program is under way with Dave Rollmann leading the activity. More information will be distributed to the membership soon via mailing along with Spring Newsletter.

The Beaver problem was again brought up. A trapper got a couple of them in the fall and not sure if all have been captured. Putting wire mesh around trees will help save the trees. The DNR has guidelines regarding beaver control.
