



Snow removal process.

The Town contracts with the county for snow removal.

The town will not plow until the snow event is finished. Unless it is an emergency. In the event of an emergency, always call 911.

Once the town contacts the county for a need to do snow plowing, as trucks break free from county routes they will start in the township, they need to have the county routes done first.

Depending on the type of snow (heavy/wet) and the weather conditions for the few days going forward will dictate calling the plows in.

Generally, we will not plow unless we get 3 or more inches of snow. (but it is possible depending on the type of snow)

After a snow event and the plowing is complete the sanding of the roads will take place the next day.

At that time, they will clean up i.e. drifts and other issues that remain for the snow event.
