May 23, 2026

Clerk's report: March 7, 2026 minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Chuck Kotlowski and seconded by Jerry Poehler to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion carried.

Treasurer's report: Ken Roberts read the Treasurer's report. Beginning cash balance of \$35,953.80. Total Cash inflows \$897.57 (lottery credit tax settlement). Cash Outflows: \$6,644.31 (Barry B. office supplies and postage, \$322.31, ACLA dues \$100.00, Aquatic Plant and Habitat Service (survey) \$2,272.00, Schmit's Aquatic (treatment) \$3,950.00). May 23 cash balance: \$30,207.06. A motion was made by Jerry Poehler to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded by Chuck Kotlowski. The motion carried.

Old Business

- A. Lake maintenance activities update: Sprayed for Curly leaf Pond Weed. Additional surveys scheduled throughout the year for weeds. Boat launch: A local contractor will leveling off the landing; they will put down a new base and gravel for \$5,500.00. The county will be paying for launch upgrade and hopes to be completed by the end of June. Weed harvesting will happen in the beginning of July and August this summer.

New Business

- A. Brennan Kearney, Wisconsin Conservation Warden: Covers all of Adams County now as his coworker just retired a week ago who also was stationed in Adams county. Brennan spoke about his duties and answered some questions from members.
- B. Open discussion: Thank you to those who participated volunteering for the Adopt a Highway area near the lake picking up trash!  
Lake aerator: Power is paid for by New Chester Township.

Tammi Rollman won the drawing for the spinning rod and reel donated by "The Minnow Bucket" in Oxford.
