Sec. 2.03.01 Town Clerk

Pursuant to sec. 60.30(1e)(a), Wis. Stats., the office of Town Clerk shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board. The term of the office for the appointed position shall be set by the Town Board, but may not exceed three (3) years per sec. 60.30(1e)(c), Wis. Stats. The Town Board may re-appoint the Town Clerk for additional terms. However, removal by the Town Board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under sec. 17.001, Wis. Stats., and required by sec. 60.30(1e)(f), Wis. Stats.

Sec. 2.03.02 Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials

- A. <u>Authority</u>. The Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under sec. 7.30(1)(b) to appoint one additional inspector at each polling place.
- B. <u>Split Shifts</u>. There shall be the option of split shifts for election workers on all election days.
- C. <u>Appointment</u>. The Town Board shall allow the clerk for each election, to appoint one (1) additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the polling place in the Town of Sumpter. Each additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.
