

**RESOLUTION 2023-01**

**RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, Wis. Statutes §7.32 allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from seven (7) to no less than three (3), and the village board has determined that it would be advantageous to the village to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mishicot, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the village board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

There shall be a minimum of three (3) election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the village clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.
