ORDINANCE NO. 2026-03.1

**AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING
OF VEHICLES ON STREETS**

Section 1. Authority

The Town of Brillion has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

Section 2. Regulation of Parking of Vehicles.

- A. The Town of Brillion, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.13, hereby establishes the following regulations for the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways:
1. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Brillion is subject to the following restrictions, and limitations: no parking on any street located in the Forest Junction Sanitary District during the period of November 1 to May 31 from 3 am to 7 am daily. The Forest Junction Sanitary District boundaries are attached as Exhibit A.
 2. Any vehicle left parked in the above-described area in violation of this ordinance is declared to be a hazard. Such vehicle will be removed by the operator, upon request. If the operator cannot be determined, an officer will issue a citation, and the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense for towing and storage fees.

Section 3. Signs.

The Town Chairperson, or his or her designee, will place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. Penalties.

No person may stop, stand, or park any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the restrictions in Section 2. Any violation is subject to a forfeiture of \$_____.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance will become effective when it is posted or published as required by Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
