**Slow-No-Wake Issued on Portion of the Rock River**

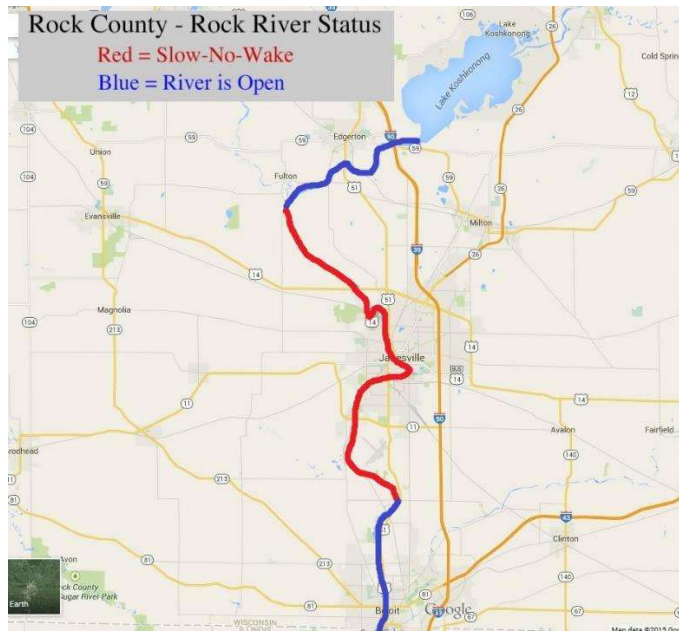

According to the US Geological Survey Gauges, the water level for the Rock River at Afton is 6.5 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction to be placed on the Rock River in Afton when the water level exceeds 6.5 feet; therefore, a slow-no-wake speed restriction is in effect on the Rock River north of the W B R Townline Bridge to the Indianford Dam.



The Sheriff's Office is providing public notice of the Rock River's current slow-no-wake status.
