Traffic Delays Due to Pistons and Props Airshow

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The Rock County Sheriff's Office in conjunction with the Pistons and Props event team would like to take this opportunity to remind the public of the upcoming Pistons and Props Air Show that will take place starting Friday, August 28th, through Sunday, August 30th. This air show will be at the Southern Wisconsin Regional Airport located at 1716 W. Airport Road, in Rock Township and will be showcasing several flying acts/aircrafts.

Due to FAA regulations surrounding some of these activities, several local roadways around the airport will be periodically closed to traffic. Roadways expected to be impacted include W. Knilians Road, which will be closed to traffic throughout the airshow, S. Oakhill Road will have restricted access in the area of the airport and W. Happy Hollow Road will be closed from Happy Hollow Park to S. River Road during flight times. Access to Glen Erin Golf Course will remain open from Airport Road.

Beyond the road closures, event traffic is expected to be heavy and will cause several delays in both directions on the S. USH 51 corridor and it is also expected to cause further back-ups on W. STH 11. It is recommended to avoid the area and use alternate routes unless you are attending this event.
