WHEREAS, the Town of Brussels has an infestation of gypsy moths, and

WHEREAS, the gypsy moth poses a danger to short and long term survival of trees and plant life in the Town of Brussels and surrounding municipalities in Door County, and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Bureau has recommended the most effective procedure of controlling the gypsy moth is probably by spraying the infested area, and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Bureau will agree to provide said spray without direct cost to the Town of Brussels,

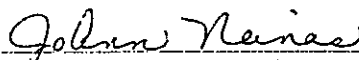
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Brussels agrees to permit the necessary spraying by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection Bureau provided that the said Department holds said Town and its officers harmless from any and all claims, lawsuits or judgments as a result of said spraying.

This resolution is made for calendar year 1990 and shall terminate on December 31, 1990.
