RESOLUTION NO. 03-2025

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BRUSSELS ROAD PROJECT FOR THE
WISCONSIN AGRICULTURAL ROADS IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (ARIP)
FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the Town of Brussels, Door County, Wisconsin, is authorized under Wisconsin State Statutes to improve and maintain its local road network; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) administers the Agricultural Roads Improvement Program (ARIP) to assist local governments with projects on roads that provide access to agricultural lands or facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brussels has identified a critical need for improvements to Brussels Road, located within the town, specifically from [Starting Point] to [Ending Point]; and

WHEREAS, this segment of Brussels Road provides vital access for agricultural producers to farms and fields, and its current condition impacts transportation efficiency, safety, and economic vitality for the local agricultural community; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project for Brussels Road will include replacing and increasing asphalt thickness to 4", adding 3" of base depth, and replacing culverts, which is expected to improve access for farm equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brussels has prepared and submitted, or intends to submit, an application for an ARIP grant to assist in funding the Brussels Road Project and

WHEREAS, the ARIP requires a local match for the project, and the Town of Brussels commits to providing its share of the local match for this project, in the amount of 10% of total costs, through Town road funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Brussels, Door County, Wisconsin:

1. That the Town of Brussels fully supports and endorses the Brussels Road application for ARIP funding.
2. That the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Chairperson to sign all necessary applications and related documents to secure said funding from WisDOT.
3. That the Town Board commits to providing the required local matching funds for the project.
4. That this resolution shall be a part of the official records of the Town of Brussels.

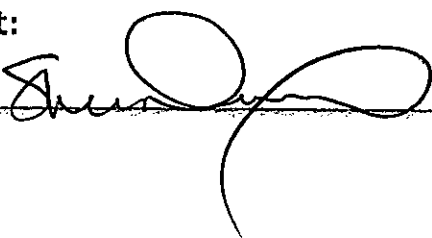
