Both DEOs continue to monitor the drug tips related to properties and/or citizens in the village. DEO's worked with the DTF for Drug Take-Back day.


School Resource Officer (SRO)


Both DEOs continue to work with SRO Dzekute at village schools and calls for service regarding students.
