#### Summary

- 132 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 4/1/2023 4/30/2023
- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

#### In the Community

- PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours. DEO's participated in National Drug Take Back on April 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Denmark Village Hall
- Coffee with a Cop Tuesday mornings from 8-9am DEO's are at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop, residents can come in ask questions, voice concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!

## Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

 Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for June 7, 2023, at 6:30PM. Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

## **Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement**

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
  - There were 30 traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and 3 traffic <u>crashes</u> in the Village of Denmark.
    - Of those traffic contacts, 24 traffic <u>citations</u> issued, and 18 traffic <u>warnings</u> issued.
    - **0 OWI** arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 7 ordinance <u>citation(s)</u> issued.

## Administrative

- Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 3 cases
- Significant Calls for Service:
  - Harassment Complaint DEO Pigeon responded to a residence in the village for a report of a victim receiving death threats via electronic means. This incident resulted in significant criminal charges, and the suspect was arrested.

- Theft Complaint- DEO Rusk responded to a residence in the village for a theft complaint. Additional information gathered at the scene resulted in concerns of stalking as well. Investigation is ongoing.
- Disturbance BCSO Deputies responded to a bar in the village for a fight between two individuals.
  Citations for underage drinking was issued, and one additional subject was not able to be identified.
- Burglary BCSO Deputies responded to a report of an over-with burglary in the village. It was reported a residence was broken into, trashed, and animal feces were smeared all over the carpet. This call resulted in an arrest

#### Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there are **2** properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.

- Sex Offender Registrants
  - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
  - Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

- Office computer for the new police office has been ordered
- New Axon Fleet dash cameras installed in both squads
- Decals for white Durango should be in any day

## **Information Bulletin**

- Park hours
  - Reminder, park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within park after hours.

## \* Animals at Large

Reminder, Village Code 111-3(A) states "No person, owner, or custodian shall permit an animal to be at large within the Village. Any animal shall be deemed to be at large when it is off the premises owned or leased by its owner or custodian unless crated, penned, or under the control of a person able to control the animal by means of a leash of sufficient strength to control the action of the animal or such other personal attention as will reasonably control the conduct and actions of the animal.

#### Off-the-road vehicles

Reminder, Village code 208-18 states "No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use"

## **Crime Prevention**

- House Check Requests
  - Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.
