Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for August 3, 2022 at 6:30PM. Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30PM (subject to change)..

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 17 traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and 6 traffic <u>crash</u> in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 20 traffic citations issued, and 8 traffic warnings issued.
 - OWI arrests / citations.
- ❖ Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 0 ordinance citation(s) issued.
- ❖ Operation Frogger (Crosswalk Enforcement) 2nd Date to be scheduled prior to the start of School.

Administrative

- **❖** Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with **0** cases.
- Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)
 - Currently, there is 3 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
 - DEO's working with Landlord(s) 2 of the properties are not renewing lease tenants removed.
- Sex Offender Registrants
 - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
 - Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ Patrol Vehicle

- ❖ Delay in parts from Whelen (lighting). Estimated 2-3 weeks out for delivery.
- Vehicle's are being changed over upon inventory arrival.

Park hours

Reminder, park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within park after hours.

Parking within the Village

Reminder, Village Code 289-5(D) states "no person shall park any vehicle on any street, roadway, highway, or alley within the village at any time for more than 48 continuous hours without movement."

Noise prohibitions

Reminder, Village Code 213-6 states "no person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing, or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb a person of ordinary sensibilities in the vicinity thereof in or about any public street, alley, park, waterway, or any private residence unless..."


Crime Prevention

These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.




