February 2021

Summary

- 105 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 2/1/2021 2/28/2021.
- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- Drug Take Back Day: DEOs hosted a collection site at the Denmark Village Hall for the Take Back event on October 24.
- As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours (8am-4:30PM).

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

- Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for March 3 at 6:30PM
- Plans are in place to present a SCAM PowerPoint in 2021 (will be based on pandemic guidelines)
- Plans in order for a public safety day (DATE TBD)

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - o In February, there were 14 traffic contacts initiated and 6 traffic crash in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 9 traffic <u>citations</u> issued and 13 traffic <u>warnings</u> issued.
 - 1 OWI citation was issued.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 5 ordinance citations issued in February.

Administrative / Training

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there is 1 property that is deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- DEOs are in continuous communication with the property owner, landlord, tenant, and neighbors to resolve the nuisance. The Denmark SRO is also an asset in assisting DEOs resolve this CNP.
- Sex Offender Registrants
 - DEOs are continuously staying up to date with any police contacts sex offender registrants residing in the Village of Denmark may have. DEOs work with the Village Board who oversees the appeal process for sex offender registrants wanting to reside in the Village of Denmark.

Joint Efforts

Crime Stoppers

Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers.
These tips are received at Crime Stoppers through phone or online. DEOs are then forwarded these tips for follow-up.

Brown County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division

- o Both DEOs continue to work closely with, communicate, and assist this division when asked to.
- Brown County Drug Task Force (BCDTF)
 - o DEOs continuously work with the BCDTF on any drug tips/cases within the Village of Denmark.
- Child Protective Services(CPS), Animal Control
 - DEOs worked together with CPS and Animal Control for various calls throughout September.
- Village of Denmark Building Inspector
 - DEOs work together with the inspector on enforcing ordinances and increasing the overall appearing/safety of the village and residents
- Denmark School Resource Officer (SRO)
 - DEOs maintain close communication with the SRO. With school opening back up in-person and the option of virtual/Independent Education Programs, DEOs work closely with the SRO on incidents involving juveniles.
- Denmark Local Businesses
 - DEOs work closely with the local businesses within Denmark. Criminal activity and/or suspicious activity that takes places on businesses property is communicated as applicable to those owners/staff.

Information Bulletin

- Park hours
 - Reminder, park hours for the general public are from 8:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. The community pool will remained closed for the remainder of the season due to COVID-19.
- Parking within the Village
 - Reminder, Village Code 289-5(D) states "no person shall park any vehicle on any street, roadway, highway, or alley within the village at anytime for more than 48 continuous hours without movement."
 - Parking from the hours of 2am-6am is also prohibited from November 1 April 1.
- Noise prohibitions
 - Reminder, Village Code 213-6 states "no person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing, or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb a person of ordinary sensibilities in the vicinity thereof in or about any public street, alley, park, waterway, or any private residence unless..."

Crime Prevention

- Neighbors App
 - Reminder, you can download the Neighbors App for FREE. It is a new tool utilized by Law Enforcement for a Neighborhood Watch program. Neighbors App can be downloaded by texting browncountywi to 555888. Being a part of this forum is another way for the community and law enforcement to come together to mitigate crime and alert real-time activity. It is not used to file a police report. Continue to call the Brown County Non-Emergency at (920) 391-7450 to file a police report or 9-1-1 in an emergency.

House Check Requests




