Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for May 4, 2022 at 6:30PM. Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30PM (subject to change)..

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 6 traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and 2 traffic <u>crash</u> in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 7 traffic <u>citations</u> issued and 7 traffic <u>warnings</u> issued.
 - **3 OWI** arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 13 ordinance citation(s) issued.
- With snow and ice comes a hazardous driving condition. Please remember to drive slow, plan accordingly and drive safely!

Administrative

- Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 3 cases.
- Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)
 - Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- Sex Offender Registrants
 - Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
 - Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.
 - Terry Siehr approved by S.O.R.B to reside in village (See posting for address location)

Information Bulletin

- Park hours
 - Reminder, park hours for the general public are from 8:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within park after hours.
- Parking within the Village
 - Reminder, Village Code 289-5(D) states "no person shall park any vehicle on any street, roadway, highway, or alley within the village at any time for more than 48 continuous hours without movement."

* Noise prohibitions

Reminder, Village Code 213-6 states "no person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing, or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb a person of ordinary sensibilities in the vicinity thereof in or about any public street, alley, park, waterway, or any private residence unless…"

Crime Prevention

House Check Requests

Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation, or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.


