Summary

- ❖ 81 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 11/1/2022 11/30/2022.
- ❖ Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- ❖ PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- Coffee with a Cop Tuesday mornings from 8-9am DEO's are at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop, residents can come in ask questions, voice concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for January 4, 2023, at 6:30PM. Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 9 traffic contacts initiated and 2 traffic crash in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 5 traffic citations issued, and 1 traffic warnings issued.
 - OWI arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 7 ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

- **❖** Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 1 case.
- **❖** Significant Calls for Service:
 - BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a weapon call
 - BCSO Deputies made a burglary arrest

- Brown County Drug Task Force located a large amount of illicit drugs during an incident in the village approx. 52 grams of Fentanyl and 200 grams of Methamphetamine removed from the Village DEO Rusk assisted
- DEO Rusk assisted with 1 eviction

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there are 2 properties deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants

Sex Offender Registrants

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ Patrol Vehicles/Equipment

- Patrol Cars will be receiving updated squad computers in 2023
- ❖ Police Department Office computer will be updated in 2023

Information Bulletin

Park hours

 Reminder, park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within park after hours.

Overnight Parking

Reminder: Village Code 289-5(B) states: "No person shall park any vehicle between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 1 on any village street."

Parking within the Village

❖ Reminder, Village Code 289-5(D) states "no person shall park any vehicle on any street, roadway, highway, or alley within the village at any time for more than 48 continuous hours without movement."

Noise prohibitions

Reminder, Village Code 213-6 states "no person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing, or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb a person of ordinary sensibilities in the vicinity thereof in or about any public street, alley, park, waterway, or any private residence unless...

Crime Prevention

House Check Requests

Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.




