VILLAGE OF DENMARK SUMMARY

- Denmark had 89 total incidents in January
- DEO Dzekute and DEO Delebreaux handled 50 of the 89 incidents in the village (56.2%)

VILLAGE OF DENMARK PATROL

- Denmark officers continue to monitor traffic, but the number of traffic stops has gone down for the month due to extra hours in the office working on administrative items.
- DEO Delebreaux made a traffic stop on a vehicle driving in a reckless manner. An ordinance citation was issued to the driver of the vehicle.
- Both DEOs worked together to pick up a person with an active warrant in the village.

BROW COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE IN DENMARK

- No ongoing investigations in the village at this time, but the DEO will be in contact with officers from the Brown County Drug Task Force to obtain any pertinent information for the village.
- There have been some drug tips brought to the DEOs and those will be checked on and turned over to the drug task force if needed.
- Both DEOs continue to monitor the drug tips to keep up to date on any possible drug activity in the village.

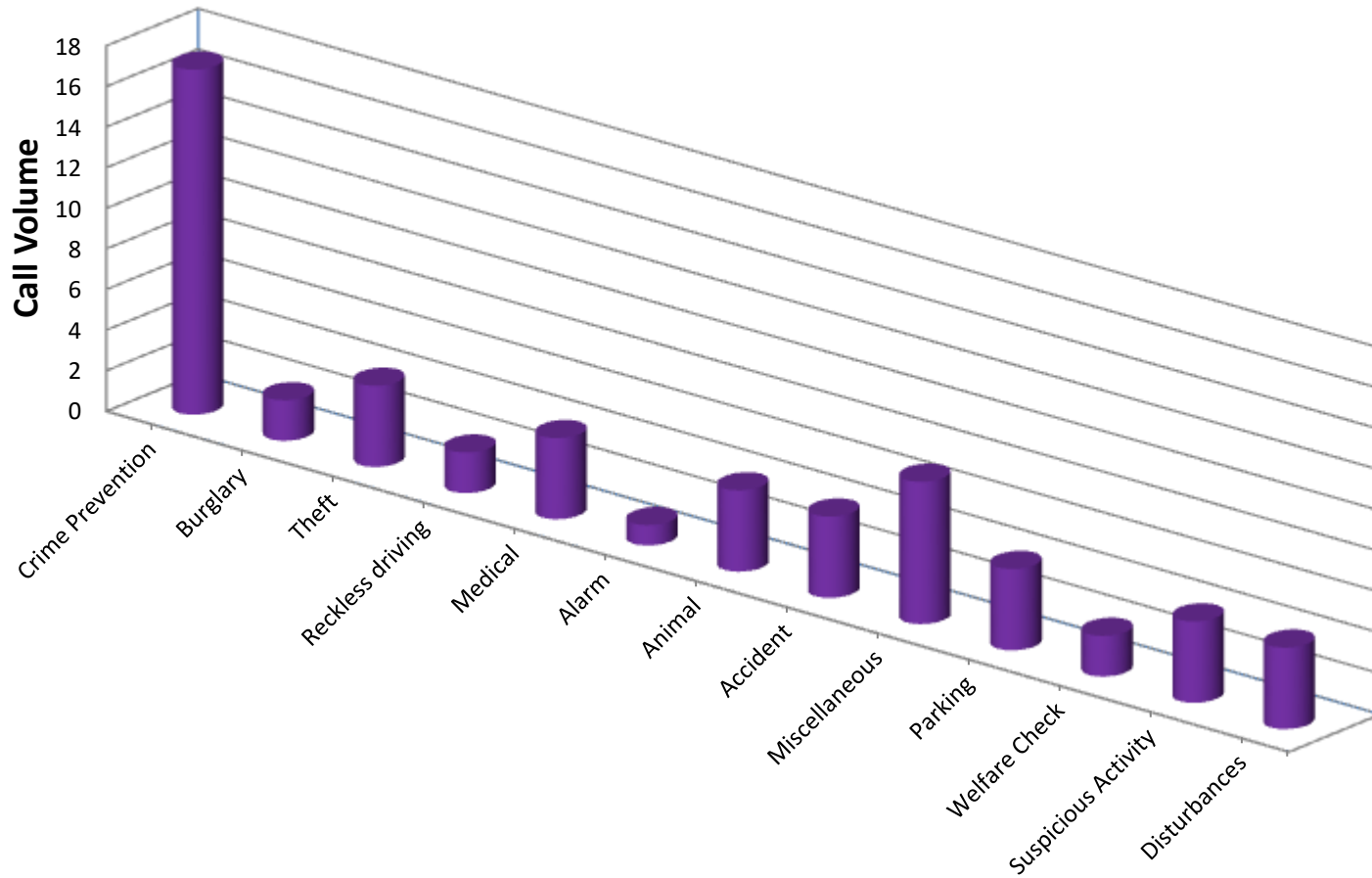
- There was 1 OWI arrest made during the month of January.

- Just a reminder from November 1 - April 1 this is no parking allowed on the streets from 2a-6a.

- 01-03-17 DEO Dzekute took a report of mailboxes that had been damaged. There were no suspects known at that time.
- 01-03-17 DEO Dzekute assisted BCSO Investigative Sgt. T. Steffens with gathering information about a student.
- 01-04-17 DEO Dzekute assisted the BCSO Investigative ICAC team with securing a room at the high school for an interview. The interview then led to an arrest.
- 01-10-17 DEO Dzekute assisted BCSO investigative Sgt. R. Aronstein with a burglary report. A statement was taken from the owner of some stolen property that was recovered.
- 01-13-17 Both DEOs assisted Erica with an ordinance violation. The violation led to the DEOs making an arrest for an active warrant.
- 01-18-17 Both DEOs attended our monthly DEO meeting at BCSO. During the meeting we received suggestions and help regarding our code book.
- 01-19-17 DEO Delebreaux was able to sit down with one of the DEOs from the Village of Suamico to try to figure out the most effective way to make the needed changes to our ordinance book.
- 01-23-17 DEO Delebreaux made an appearance at the girls basketball game
- 01-24-17 DEO Delebreaux responded to a medical call at the high school. A wrestler dislocated his elbow. The male was treated by first responders on scene and was transported to the hospital.
- 01-25-17 DEO Dzekute responded to a 2 vehicle accident that happened in front of the high school. It was a minor accident with no injuries.
- 01-26-17 DEO Dzekute conducted a lockdown drill at the elementary school. The drill went very well. The students and staff did an excellent job.
- 01-26-17 DEO Dzekute responded to the middle school for a student who was thinking about suicide and didn't feel that she could keep herself safe. She was transported to the crisis center for an evaluation and then to a facility for a voluntary evaluation.
- 01-26-17 DEO Delebreaux made an appearance at the boys basketball game
- 01-27-17 DEO Dzekute debriefed the lockdown drill with the elementary school staff. There were some questions answered as well as some learning points that we can use for our next drill.
- 01-27-17 DEO Dzekute gave a presentation to Mr. Weigman's personal planning class.
- 01-27-17 Both DEOs attempted to do some follow-up on a sex offender that is living in the village. No contact was made at the residence at that time but the DEOs will attempt again.

- 01-28-17 DEO Dzekute attended the 5k snowshoe race that was held at Neshota Park. They had a great day for the event and all the participants seemed to enjoy the event (Everything but the hills). Hopefully the event will continue to grow and maybe next year there will be a little more snow for the race.
- 01-28-17 DEO Dzekute attended the basketball tournament at the schools. The event appeared to be a big success.
- 01-31-17 Both DEOs had a meeting with Bob Mc Cabe regarding the sex offender board and the rules for an offender moving into the village. The meeting was very informative and we will be able to continue with our evaluation and possible changes to the process.

INFORMATION BULLETIN

- Now that we are getting into tax time you may see an increase in scams claiming to be from the IRS. A big thing to remember is that the IRS is going to use the postal service if there is going to be any contact. If you receive a call that you feel is a possible scam **don't** give out any information and call in the incident.
- Just a reminder to keep all vehicles, homes, and outbuildings locked. We may trust our neighbors, but can we always trust the stranger that finds their way into the village. **DON'T** be a "soft target" for criminal activity.
- It is important to remember to call in any type of suspicious activity. With the recent string of thefts we have had some incidents that have not been called in when they happen. The sooner the activity gets called in the sooner we can get officers in the area and hopefully get this problem to stop. The number to call is **920-391-7450**. If it's an emergency always dial 911.
- The voicemail in the DEO office is now set up. We will be checking the voicemail throughout our shift. If you need an officer to come out please continue to use the non-emergency number listed above or below or 911 for an emergency.
- If there are any drug issues that you notice throughout the village and you would like to report them please call the **Brown County Drug Task Force tip line: 920-437-DRUG(3784)**. The tips that come in from the village will get sent and viewed by both DEOs. We can then follow up on the tips.
