
OWI ARRESTS IN DENMARK

DEO'S IN DENMARK

- DEOs continue to monitor before and after school traffic for violations and reckless driving from students and parents.
- DEO Delebreau was able to pick up one person who had an active arrest warrant in the village.
- DEOs Dzekute and Delebreau conducted compliance checks at the village establishments that sell alcohol.
- DEOs continue to evaluate the specific enforcement needs of the village. Strategic plans and scheduling will allow us to continue to monitor problem areas as well as times of heightened problem rates in the village.







- 05-05-16 DEO Dzekute gave a presentation to Mr. Weigman's sophomore planning class. Great class with lots of good questions. I even had some volunteers to try some of our physical testing.
- 05-07-16 Both DEOs worked the village wide rummage sale. One parking issue that was taken care of and one accident.
- 05-10-16 DEO Dzekute was present at the middle school for a meeting with some parents. There were no issues during the meeting.
- 05-14-16 DEO Dzekute was able to stop in at the Denmark Sting Cancer Walk at the high school. It appeared to be a good turn out and everyone seemed to be having fun. Thank you to everyone who participated and helped put on the event.
- 05-14-16 DEO Dzekute assisted the county with a serious 2 vehicle accident at the intersection of CTH T and Park Rd.
- 05-14-16 DEO Dzekute was able to assist with the Fire Dept. 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary parade. The weather could've been a little nicer but that didn't stop people from coming out to help celebrate.
- 05-17-16 DEO Delebreau assisted the high school by evaluating a student who was possibly impaired by drugs. No legal action was needed at that time.
- 05-18-16 DEO Delebreau took a report of a burglary to the storage units on Copenhagen. There were 3 units that were broken into, but nothing had been taken.
- 05-18-16 DEO Dzekute conducted a level 3 lockdown drill at the elementary school. The drill went great. All students and staff did an excellent job during the drill.
- 05-20-16 Both DEOs worked together to complete compliance checks at the establishments that sell alcohol in the village. Of the nine establishments checked, four of them sold to our underage volunteer customers.
- 05-25-16 DEO Dzekute took a report of a burglary to a house on Main St. The incident is still under investigation.
- 05-26-16 DEO Dzekute conducted a level 3 lockdown drill at the middle school. The drill went great and the staff and students did an excellent job of executing their responsibilities.
- 05-26-16 DEO Dzekute participated in a last day event with the seniors. A foot race was arranged on the track. The race looked like it was going to be one sided, but in the end it was a close race.
- 05-27-16 DEO Delebreau attended the graduation ceremony at the high school.



- We are starting to see an increase in thefts and burglaries throughout the county so continue to make your vehicles and houses hard targets. Lock your doors. Make sure valuables aren't left out for easy access. Most of the thefts and burglaries are "Stop and grab" crimes. The criminals tend to stop at the "easy targets" that they know they can get some property quickly and get away.
- Now that school is out there will be a lot more kids around. Please drive carefully through the village since they will be out walking, running, and riding bikes.
- With the warm weather and the increase in time we spend outside make sure you are taking in enough fluids, especially water. We see an increase in rescue calls related to the heat. Also make sure you protect your skin while outside. No one likes sunburn.
- We are still seeing a lot of scams involving calls claiming to be from the IRS. Do not give out any information to these calls.
- We are seeing scams involving calls stating a person has warrants or they will be picked up by the police for crimes. Don't give out any info to these callers. If you can't remember if you have anything in your past give either DEO a call and we can try to help you through this.
- We are also getting more scams involving calls stating the person has won a prize. As tempting as it might be to claim the "\$2.5 million prize" do not give out any information.
