VILLAGE OF DENMARK SUMMARY

- Denmark had 131 total incidents in November
- DEO Dzekute and DEO Delebreaux handled 90 of the 131 incidents in the village (68.7%)

VILLAGE OF DENMARK PATROL

- Denmark officers made 9 traffic stops and issued 1 verbal warning, 10 traffic citations, and 0 parking tickets.
- 21 Parking warnings were given out for overnight parking in the village.

BROW COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE IN DENMARK

- No ongoing investigations in the village at this time.
- There have been some drug tips brought to the DEOs and those will be checked on and turned over to the drug task force if needed.

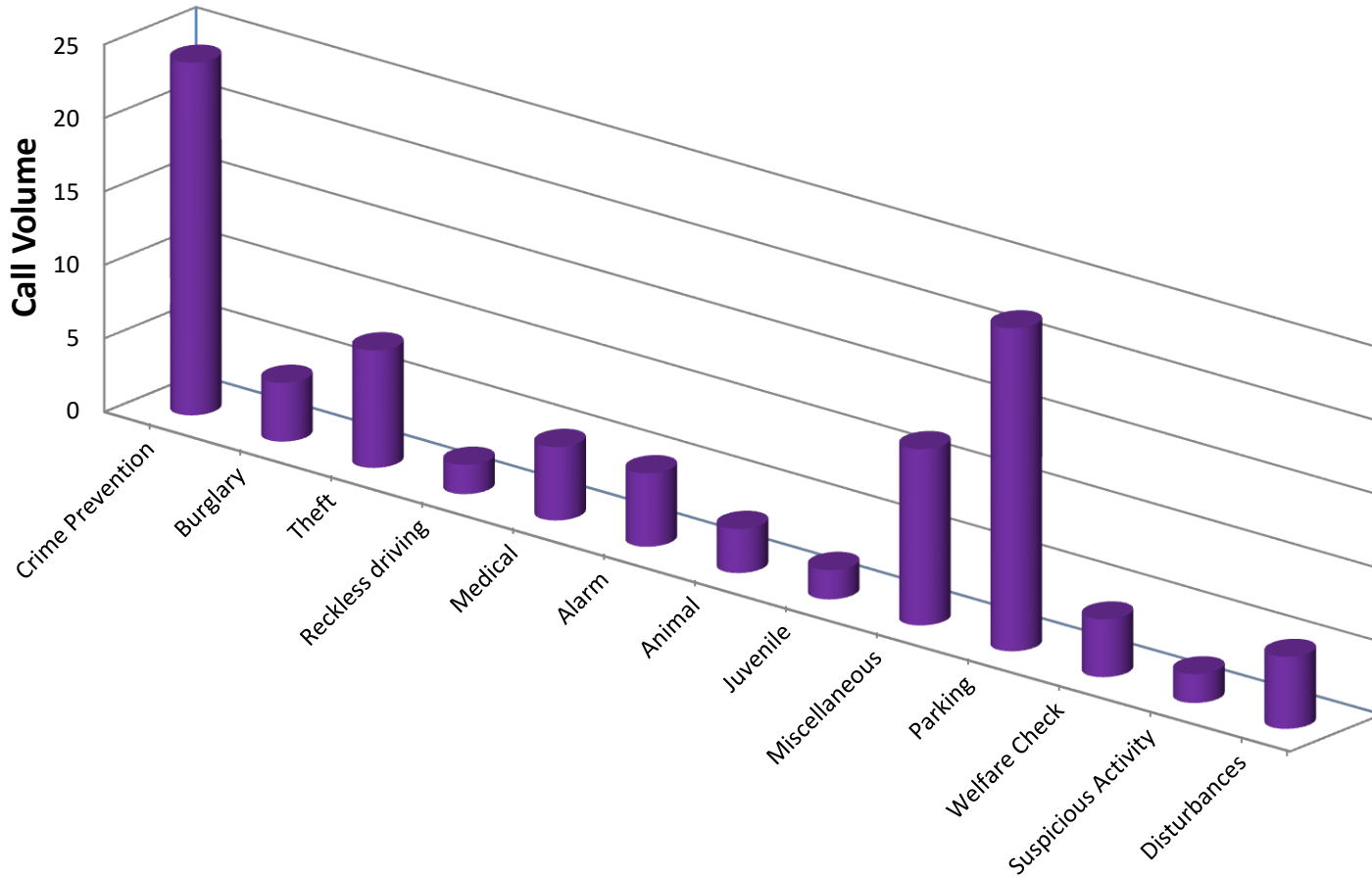
- There were 0 OWI arrests made.

- 11-01-16 Both DEOs assisted with active shooter training with county rescue.
- 11-04-16 DEO Dzekute responded to a medical call at Salm Partners. The initial call was a female patient who wasn't breathing or responsive. Once on scene the female was breathing, responsive, and was able to talk. Rescue transported the female to the hospital to be checked out.
- 11-09-16 DEO Delebreaux looked into two different animal complaints that had come into our office.
- 11-10-16 DEO Delebreaux began overnight parking enforcement around the village. He placed **parking warnings** on numerous vehicles throughout the village. They were **NOT** parking tickets at this time. In the future parking tickets may be issued for vehicles parked on the streets from 2a-6a.
- 11-10-16 DEO Dzekute assisted a County Deputy who was working on a damage report that happened outside the village. Arranged time to speak with students at the high school who may have had information about the incident.
- 11-11-16 DEO Dzekute was dispatched to a verbal disturbance. Upon arrival it turned out to be a civil matter about some property at a house. Officers stood by while the property was sorted through and arranged for a later pick-up.
- 11-14-16 DEO Dzekute worked on locating the owner of some debit cards that were found in the village. The owner's current residence was located and the cards and DL were mailed to the owner.
- 11-15-16 DEO Dzekute helped DPW with the old municipal garage by removing all the found bicycles. The bikes were logged and transferred to the Brown County Sheriff's Office.
- 11-17-16 DEO Dzekute responded to a suspicious situation at Dufeck Manufacturing. They had found a backpack near the corner of their property. The backpack contained school books and there was previous knowledge that someone had their backpack taken from their vehicle over the night. DEO Dzekute was able to contact the owner of the backpack and it was returned.
- 11-21-16 DEO Dzekute was called to the high school for a student who had taken too much medication during the weekend. The student was talked to and it was determined that there was no need for law enforcement action at that time.
- 11-22-16 DEO Dzekute was called for a vehicle that was entered over the night. The vehicle had been left unlocked. The owner of the vehicle did not want anything reported, but wanted the DEOs to know about the incident.
- 11-23-16 DEO Dzekute located a suspicious vehicle while patrolling for our theft suspect. The vehicle was located at the storage units next to the CO-OP. The driver was id'ed and it was found out that the driver was an employee of a local business who was on break.

- 11-28-16 DEO Delebreaux took a theft report for a vehicle that was entered during the night.
- 11-29-16 DEO Delebreaux took a theft report for a vehicle that was entered during the night.
- 11-29-16 DEO Delebreaux took a burglary report at Prime Storage. Several units had the locks cut off and there were some items taken. At this time there are no suspects.
- 11-30-16 DEO Dzekute responded to a rescue call where a female had fallen and hit her head on the ground. Rescue was called to check out the patient and no medical transport was required. DEO Dzekute stood by while the female arranged for a ride to the doctor to be checked.

INFORMATION BULLETIN

- We have had some incidents in the village of vehicles that have been entered during the night. Just a reminder to keep all vehicles, homes, and outbuildings locked. We may trust our neighbors, but can we always trust the stranger that finds their way into the village. Don't be a "soft target" for criminal activity.
- It is important to remember to call in any type of suspicious activity. With the recent string of thefts we have had some incidents that have not been called in when they happen. The sooner the activity gets called in the sooner we can get officers in the area and hopefully get this problem to stop. The number to call is **920-391-7450**. If it's an emergency always dial 911.
- The village will be getting a voicemail set up on the phone line in the DEO office. If we are not available please leave a message and one of us will get in touch as soon as we can. We will be checking the voicemail throughout our shift.
