

- DEO Dzekute conducted the drug take back event during the trade fair at the high school. There wasn't as much turned in which is a good thing because that means we don't have as many bottles of pills out in our community. We will continue to keep the drop box in the village hall, but there will be some different instructions that will be posted for the box.
- Both DEOs worked during the trick-or-treating hours. The night was a great success with the biggest problem we had was running out of treats to give to the kids. Thank you to everyone for making the night a great and safe outing. It was great to see all the different costumes out there.
- DEOs continue to evaluate the specific enforcement needs of the village. Strategic plans and scheduling will allow us to continue to monitor problem areas as well as times of heightened problem rates in the village.





- 10-03-16 DEO Dzekute did a welfare check on a male sleeping at the post office. The male had left his residence due to an argument and sleept in the entryway. He was checked and sent on his way.
- 10-03-16 DEO Delebreau responded to an apprehension request from Probation and Parole. He took a suspect into custody and transported him to the jail.
- 10-05-16 DEO Delebreau placed the speed board near the intersection of Wall St. and Hager Rd.
- 10-06-16 DEO Dzekute responded to a call at the middle school for some sexually explicit messages that were being sent between students. The incident was investigated and the report was forwarded to CPS for review.
- 10-09-16 DEO Delebreau completed a report for a stolen pedestrian crossing sign. The sign was later returned to its proper place.
- 10-11-16 DEO Delebreau was called to assist the Brown County investigative division at the high school.
- 10-13-16 DEO Dzekute gave a presentation to Mrs. Albers class at the high school.
- 10-13-16 DEO Dzekute was called to pick up a student who refused to come to school. The student was transported to school without further incident.
- 10-13-16 DEO Dzekute was dispatched to 367 Danish Way to take possession of some drugs and drug paraphernalia that was found in an apartment building.
- 10-13-16 DEO Dzekute received information of a possible sexting incident between two students at the high school. The incident was investigated and there were no charges needed.
- 10-13-16 DEO Dzekute took a theft report at the high school. Some money had been taken out of a teacher's purse. The incident is still under investigation at this time.
- 10-17-16 DEO Delebreau gave a presentation to the driver's education class at the high school.
- 10-17-16 DEO Dzekute talked to Ms. Gleeson about a student at the middle school who was possible drinking and then bragging about it at school. We were able to establish a game plan to handle the issue if it continues.
- 10-19-16 Both DEOs responded to the ECC for a panic alarm. The alarm was false and there were no issues.
- 10-19-16 DEO Dzekute responded to 367 Danish Way for a keep the peace while a tenant retrieved some property. There was an issue with the eviction of the tenant and it is being investigated by DEO Dzekute.
- 10-21-16 DEO Dzekute responded to the middle school for a student who had wrote a note detailing an act of suicide. The student was taken to the crisis center and evaluated.
- 10-22-16 DEO Dzekute conducted the drug take back event during the trade fair at the high school.
- 10-25-16 DEO Delebreau responded to De Grand's Restaurant for a suspicious substance that was found. The substance was tested and the result was negative for being some sort of drugs.



- 10-30-16 DEO Delebreau responded to a fire call at 367 Danish Way to assist with the scene.
- 10-31-16 Both DEOs monitored the Halloween activities around the village.
- 10-31-16 DEO Delebreau assisted Probation and Parole with a compliance check in the village. The check led to an apprehension request and DEO Delebreau taking a subject into custody. The subject was transported to the jail.

- We have had some incidents in the village of vehicles that have been entered during the night. Just a reminder to keep all vehicles, homes, and outbuildings locked. - The village will be getting a voicemail set up on the phone line in the DEO office. If we are not available please leave a message and one of us will get in touch as soon as we can. We will be checking the voicemail throughout our shift.
