Summary

- 149 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 10/1/2023 10/31/2023
- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK As a reminder, this drop off site is open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. Residents can come in ask questions, voice concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- Trunk or Treat The Denmark DEO's participated in this year's Denmark Trunk or Treat event in front of the Denmark Middle School. We handed out candy, and children and families got to check out the Brown County Sheriff's Office Bearcat.

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **December 6, 2023**, at 6:30PM. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 33 traffic contacts initiated and 1 traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 13 traffic <u>citations</u> issued, and 40 traffic <u>warnings</u> issued.
 - **0 OWI** arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There was 17 ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 2 cases.

Significant Calls for Service:

- Disturbance BCSO deputies responded to the Village for a domestic dispute. The reporting party indicated the suspect broke down the door to a residence. One arrest was made resulting in numerous domestic abuse related charges.
- Hit & Run BCSO Deputies responded to Prospect St and N Wall St for accident call. A utility pole was hit by a vehicle causing the pole to break and fall over. The driver left the scene prior to the officer's arrival.
- Drug Call SRO Dzekute assisted K9 handlers in conducting searches inside the school and parking lot.
- Drug Call The Brown County Drug Task Force executed a search warrant at a residence in the Village.
 A large amount of fentanyl pills, cash, and firearms were located in the residence. This incident resulted in arrests and numerous charges being pursued.
- Sexual Assault DEO Pigeon and DEO Rusk along with Brown County Sheriff's Office Investigators and Patrol Deputies investigated a Sexual Assault that occurred in the Village. This incident resulted in an arrest.

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- o Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.

Sex Offender Registrants

- o Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently **0** Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

- Flock Cameras The Village of Denmark Village Board approved the purchase of two Flock Cameras. The cameras will be operating in 2023.

Information Bulletin

Park hours

 Reminder, park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within the park after hours.

* Nighttime Parking Prohibited

Reminder, Village Code 289-5(B) states "No person shall park any vehicle between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to April 1 on any Village Street."

9PM Routine

 Due to the large amounts of thefts from vehicles and thefts from garages lately, it is recommended residents implement a 9 PM routine to ensure car doors and residence doors are kept locked, valuables are removed from your vehicles and hidden, exterior lights are left on, and making sure the garage door is closed. These are all small easy steps everyone can take to help deter criminal activity in our neighborhoods.

* Off-the-road vehicles

 Reminder, Village code 208-18 states "No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use" – Other vehicles includes golf carts,

Crime Prevention

- House Check Requests
 - Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.


