- ❖ Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be Tuesday April 2, 2024. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!
- ❖ Boy Scouts Presentation On Thursday, March 7, DEO Rusk did a presentation for a Boy Scouts troop at the Denmark Troop 1052 Scout Cabin.

❖ Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for **April 3**, **2024**, at 6:30PM. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were 24 traffic contacts initiated and 1 traffic crashes in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, 19 traffic <u>citations</u> were issued, and 26 traffic <u>warnings</u> were issued.
 - 0 OWI arrests / citations.
- ❖ Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 10 ordinance citation(s) issued.

Administrative

- ❖ Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 2 cases.
- Significant Calls for Service:

- Domestic Disturbance DEO Pigeon and DEO Rusk responded to a residence in the Village for a disturbance that resulted in an arrest for domestic abuse related charges.
- Weapon Call Brown County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to the Village for a weapon call. This
 call generated a large police response. This call did not result in any arrests and turned out to be a
 misunderstanding.
- Missing Person Brown County Deputies responded to the Village for a report of two missing children. Missing child calls result in a response from all available law enforcement officers in Brown County. The children were located and were safe.

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.

Sex Offender Registrants

- Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
- Currently 0 Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

❖ Patrol Vehicles/Equipment

- Speed Board We have received the new speed board from Elan City, and with the warmer weather months approaching we will have it set up in various locations throughout the Village.
- Flock Cameras The Flock cameras have been installed on DePere Rd near the off ramp from I-43 NB and CTH R north of DePere Rd.

Park hours

Reminder, Memorial Park hours for the public are from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No person shall be present in the park after hours. Parking ordinances are also enforced within the park after hours.

Nighttime Parking Prohibited

Reminder, Village Code 289-5(B) states "No person shall park any vehicle between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00
 a.m. from November 1 to April 1 on any Village Street."

Off-the-road vehicles

Reminder, Village code 208-18 states "No person shall ride or operate, or permit a child to operate, any bicycle, minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle or other vehicle except in areas specially designated for its use" – Other vehicles includes golf carts,

House Check Requests

Remember, if you're leaving town for a weekend or taking a vacation or traveling –fill out a house check request form; it can be located on the village website. These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.




