Summary

- 87 calls for service in the Village of Denmark from 3/1/2024 3/31/2024
- Brown County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) deputies provide additional enforcement, police services and respond to calls for service when DEOs are not available.

In the Community

- PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK National Drug Take Back Day is Saturday, April 27, 2024. Denmark DEO's will be at the Denmark Village Hall collecting medication from 8:00 AM-12:00 PM for this event. As a reminder, this drop off site is also open Monday Friday during normal Village of Denmark municipal hours.
- Coffee with a Cop Denmark Officers will be at DeGrand Family Restaurant for Coffee with a Cop the first Tuesday of the month from 8-9 AM. The next event will be Tuesday May 7, 2024. Residents can come in to ask questions, voice their concerns, and get to know the Village Officers!

Meetings, Associations & Presentations.

Denmark Municipal Court is scheduled for May 1, 2024, at 6:30PM. Denmark Municipal Court is normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month at 6:30 PM (subject to change).

Traffic / Ordinance Enforcement

- Officers use traffic enforcement as one mean to modify, correct and educate operators on dangerous driving behavior. Traffic citations are issued to gain compliance with the law.
 - There were **17** traffic <u>contacts</u> initiated and **6** traffic <u>crashes</u> in the Village of Denmark.
 - Of those traffic contacts, **10** traffic <u>citations</u> were issued, and **18** traffic <u>warnings</u> were issued.
 - 0 OWI arrests / citations.
- Ordinance citations are used to enforce the codes that are specific to Denmark. There were 4 ordinance <u>citation(s)</u> issued.

Administrative

- Denmark DEO's actively assisting BCSO Investigative with 0 cases.
- Significant Calls for Service:
 - School Bus Accident BCSO Deputies responded to the Village for a report of a school bus vs car crash. No serious injuries.
 - Fraud Call DEO Rusk responded to a complaint of a Fraud that occurred at Family Dollar. A subject paid for gift cards with counterfeit \$100 bills. The currency passed the counterfeit detection pen results, but under further investigation the bills were discovered to have the same serial numbers. There is an attempt to identify the suspect on BCSO Social Media pages.
 - Chronic Nuisance Brown County Deputies responded to the Village for a report of a disturbance in the Village regarding a chronic nuisance property. One municipal citation was issued for chronic nuisance prohibited.
 - Domestic Disturbance DEO Pigeon responded to a residence in the Village for a welfare check that resulted in Domestic Abuse charges.

Chronic Nuisance Properties (CNP)

- Currently, there is 1 property deemed a CNP in the Village of Denmark.
- DEO's working with Landlord(s)/tenants.
- Sex Offender Registrants
 - o Currently there are no active Sex Offender Residency Appeals.
 - Currently **0** Sex Offender (pending) Appeal process for Residency within the Village.

 - Both DEOs continue to monitor anonymous tips that come in through Green Bay Area Crime Stoppers.

These forms are forwarded to DEOs for documentation, checks, and extra patrol. These checks offer extra supervision over your home and provide DEOs information on who to contact while you are away if needed as well as what to expect for activity/vehicles at your home.


